- c1770-75 Martin Streetman, son of Martin Streetman and Elizabeth _____ was born in Loudon Co VA. His father Martin Streetman was naturalized in New Jersey August 20, 1755.¹ Martin and Elizabeth Streetman relocated to Loudon Co VA by 1764. The 1820 and 1830 census place Martin's birth range 1770-1775.

In three tax entries (below), Martin Streetman is the agent for Ann (or Anny) Streetman. Perhaps this was his wife's name instead of Ada.
